IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT CLOSURE OF TRINITY MEDICAL CENTRE

NHS Bromley Clinical Commissioning Group previously wrote to you on 6th March 2020 to inform you that your current GP practice, Trinity Medical Centre is due to close. We are now part of South East London Clinical Commissioning Group (SEL CCG) and writing to you again to update you on the closure of your current practice.

A caretaking provider has now been appointed for a 3 month period from 1st April 2020 to 30th June 2020 to provide GP services, support patients to register with new services safely and help with the practice closure process. The provider is Bromley GP Alliance, a local health care organisation. All patients are now advised they will need to register with neighbouring GP practices within the next 8 weeks.

What do I need to do now?

Please re-register with another local practice. Once you have done this, your medical records will be transferred electronically to your new practice. To assist you with making your choice, included here is a table of nearby practices who have confirmed they are registering new patients. To make it easier to re-register during this period of time, local practices are able to accept registrations online, by email or by contacting them by phone. Please ensure that you have checked your home postcode is within the catchment area for the practice you are looking to register with; you can do this on the practice's website.

Please note, there may be other GP practices that are closer to where you live. You can go online to <https://www.nhs.uk/service-search/find-a-gp> to search for local practices using the 'Find GP services' tool. You will also find useful information and patient reviews on this website to help you make your decision, or you may prefer to speak to the local surgery of your choice directly. Staff in those practices can answer queries and support you through the registration process.
